Newsletters so often are filled with “you shall nots,” and often don’t stress all of the positive efforts of the Board and residents of our community. So instead, this Newsletter focuses on the positives.

First, summer is over, the kids are back in school and cooler weather and football games are signals that the holiday seasons are fast approaching. The holidays – a time for family and friends! In a couple of weeks, it will be Halloween. Trick or treating for the children and costume parties for all truly start the holiday season. Thanksgiving follows, and before we know it Hanukkah, Christmas, and the New Year will be here.

In the early years of Reed’s Landing, neighbors got together for an adult community Christmas Party at the home of one of the residents. Over the years, as Reed’s Landing grew and the number of residents increased, the event had to be moved off-site to accommodate all of those who wanted to attend. And then as often happens, the committee got tired and the Party got lost in the comings and goings of the holidays.

Over the past year, a number of residents have asked if we might restart the event. The answer is Yes! Debbie Lilley and Candace Cody have agreed to chair a committee to bring back the **Reed’s Landing Holiday Christmas Party**. What a great chance to socialize with our Reed’s Landing neighbors, and to welcome in the holiday season by renewing what we hope becomes a Reed’s Landing tradition that will continue to grow.

This year the Party will be at Stonehenge Country Club, December 4th, from 6:30 – 11:00 p.m. The cost is \$75 per couple. Live Entertainment and a cash bar are included!!!! Black Tie is optional!! Adults only. We are limited to only 100 couples and a number of residents have already placed their reservations. Second, this past summer’s extreme heat and lack of rain delayed starting the improvements to the landscaping. We have now begun upgrading and improving the various common areas in the community, and will continue the upgrades on a three to five year schedule. We’ve made improvements to the entrance area, to the area around the Gate House, and to the area at Reed’s Landing Road and Reed’s Landing Circle.

Third, a generator is being installed to provide power to the Gate House area, including the gates and security lighting, so that we can continue to have security during periods of electrical outages to the community.

Fourth, the Celebration Walkway by the gazebo was finished just prior to the recent Community Picnic. Thank you to everyone who has already purchased a brick. Finally, remember to exercise your right to vote on November 2nd. Note that our by-laws do not permit election-related signs to be placed in yards or on common grounds.
